INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Prior to the erection or alteration of any agricultural structure, an application for an Agricultural Exemption Certificate may be submitted by the owner.
- 2. Completed application forms for an Agricultural Exemption Certificate shall be submitted to the office of the Zoning Administrator.
- 3. Agricultural Use of a building is defined as housing farm implements, hay, grain, poultry, livestock or other horticultural products.
- 4. If determined by the Zoning Administrator to be eligible for an agricultural exemption, the Agricultural Exemption Certificate shall be approved and attached to the Building Permit. Such designation shall exempt the structure from the payment of any fees. However, the Agricultural Exemption Certificate shall not exempt the use of the building or structure from a future non-agricultural use or any rezoning or Conditional Use requirements necessary under the applicable Zoning Regulations for such conversion to a non-agricultural use.
- 5. Structures issued an Agricultural Exemption shall not be used as a place of human habitation or a place of employment where agricultural products are processed, treated or packaged, nor shall it be a place used by the public.
