Application Requirements for Water Well Installation Permit

Permits are required in Seward County.

Required Documents:

- Completed Application and fee
- Current **Seward County and State of Kansas** license
- Site plan drawn to scale showing location and/or proposed location of water well, septic system, home and any accessory structures, and adjacent or adjoining roads
- Proposed location must be in compliance with separation requirements as specified in the Seward County Sanitation Codes and by KDHE Bulletin 4-2

Well Completion log must be submitted to close out permit.

IF THIS IS A REPLACEMENT WELL, THE ABANDONED WELL MUST BE PLUGGED IN ACCORDANCE WITH KDHE REQUIREMENTS.

Well plugging log must be submitted.

Remember to call 8-1-1 or 1-800-dig-safe (1-800-344-7233) before you dig.

Applications will be approved or denied within 10 working days after receipt of all required items.
